#### Rules and Conditions of Entry:

Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions

Before riding PCAV membership cards must be inspected at the Secretary's desk.

- ALL Open riders including PCAV members riding in an OPEN section Must sign a day participation form available on [www.ponyclubvic.org.au](http://www.ponyclubvic.org.au). If you cannot produce a registration card you must pay \$10.00 fee.
- Medical armbands must be worn by ALL competitors.
- No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted. (Showjumping & pre purchased show tickets competitors only)
- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply, and acceptance of these rules.
- The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times, and refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- PCAV gear rules apply to all competitors. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
- Times: All riders MUST be prepared to ride 15 minutes earlier than the posted times if required and must gear check at least 30 min prior to their allocated time for each event.
- Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
- No stallions, colts or rigs.
- Dogs are prohibited without exception.
- **The organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Showjumping competitors must supply their own bridle or saddlecloth numbers.**
- PCAV alcohol and smoking policies apply.
- No lunging permitted.
- All horses must be aged at least four.
- Disclaimer of Liability: Neither the organizer, nor anyone acting on their behalf accept liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, owners or ground spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever.

#### PONY CLUB SHOWJUMPING TEAMS

- Teams of 3 or 4 riders from the same club (can be different grades) may enter. However composite teams will be accepted.
- The next three individual placing points will count towards the team total. Only riders who complete all 3 phases without elimination are eligible for overall winner and team scores.
- Points will be allocated in each class from 6 points to 1<sup>st</sup> place down to 1 point for 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Riders must enter all three phases as individuals to be eligible as a team.
- Please indicate other team members on your own entry form. If you are not riding in an allocated team, please indicate on entry and you will be put into composite teams on the day.
- No equal placing for overall winner, a count back will be taken back to the AMS competition.
- Count back for team's competition will be based on the overall score of the lowest place rider on the team. i.e. rider (3)
- Riders must not be eliminated in any phase for their scores to be counted
